It is strongly recommended that you do not ship your vehicle until after you receive your Import Approval

- Carefully read the <u>Importing Vehicles to Australia</u> publication by DOTARS Vehicle Safety Standards before completing this application. The brochure can be downloaded from <u>www.dotars.gov.au/roads/safety/bulletin/importing.aspx</u>
- Any missing documents or incomplete applications will delay the issuing Import Approval. You will need an Import Approval to take delivery of your vehicle from the Australian Port of entry.
- Allow up to 17 days from receipt of your application and all documentation for processing and issue of an Approval.
- A fee of \$50.00 must accompany this application. Refer to page 3 of this document for payment options.
